Dear Mr. Clarke:

The U.S. Department of Defense (DOD), Freedom of Information Division, Office of Litigation Support, is responding to your February 21, 2014, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records to the U.S. Department of State on behalf of your clients, Accuracy in Media, Inc., a non-profit corporation, as well as the following seven individuals, all of whom serve as members of the "Citizens' Commission on Benghazi," an unincorporated, informal association of individuals, all working with Accuracy in Media. Your clients are identified as (1) Roger Aronoff, (2) Larry Bailey, (3) Kenneth Benway, (4) Dick Brauer, (4) Clare Lopez, (5) James A. Lyons, Jr., (5) Kevin Shipp, and (7) Wayne Simmons.

The Department of State referred twelve (12) documents consisting of forty-three (43) pages of documents for a direct response to you. The appropriate Department of Defense components reviewed the enclosed twelve responsive documents and recommended information be withheld from release citing the 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(1) in accordance with Executive Order 13526, as amended, Sections 1.4(b), 1,4(c) and 1,4(d); (b)(3) as it relates to 10 U.S.C. § 424 protecting organizational and personnel information for the Defense Intelligence Agency and 50 U.S.C. § 3024(i) which protects intelligence sources and methods; (b)(6) which pertains to personal information affecting an individual's privacy (b)(7(C) which protects records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information could be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of privacy and (b)(7)(E) which allows agencies to withhold information compiled for law enforcement purposes if disclosure would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.

Appellate rights are moot as your request is currently in litigation.

4. (S//NE) The leader of BCOAR is Abdul Baset ((AZUZ)), AZUZ was sent by ((ZAWARI)) to set up Al Qaeca (AQ) bases in Libya. It was stated that AZUZ was not a charismatic leader but rather just a violent radical. He is also a member of the Abu Slim Martyrs Fatiba, run by Fati ((AGIB)). 5. (S//NT) Within the last year AZUZ established the Al-Tawheed (Oneness of God) college in Derna, the establishment of this college was authorized by the Ministry of Education with the approval of the Under Secretary of the Ministry of Education, Fathi ((AL-KA*ARY)), a member of the Muslim brother hood movement and currently one of the eight presidential candidates. Al-Tawheed College is the headquarters of ECOAR and is located next to the main Derna hospital. The majority of its members are under the age of 28 with a large number between the ages of 17-21 years of age. AZUZ has managed to establish a headquarters and training facility in Derna, they train in the mountains surrounding ferna where they have large caches of weapons. Some of these caches are disguised by feeding troughs for livestock. They have SA-7 and SA-23/4 MANPADS as well as unidentified missiles over two meters in length. They train almost every day focusing on religious lessons and scripture including three lessons a day of finadist ideology. <u>6. (S//NE)</u> Approximately 120 men of the BCOAR train in this area and sometimes they are joined by other radical groups such as Abu Slim Martyrs Katiba, Ansar al Sharia Katiba.
