

Release from DOD's National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency ("NGA"), 15 records totaling 92 pages. Released in part. Redactions under FOIA exemptions (b)(1), 1.4(c), re intelligence activities, covert action, sources, methods, or cryptology. Exemptions also under (b)(3), incorporating 10 U.S.C. § 424, exempting organizational and personnel information of NGA (and DIA and NRO).

Apparently responsive to request for records of DOD assets pre-positioned off the coast of Libya in October 2011, although records are dated through 9/1/11 through 9/20/11. Request made to 4 DOD components (Compl. ¶ 36), and State (Compl. ¶ 110(4)). (This request to State was withdrawn).

Dear Mr. Clarke:

This letter is in response to the referral received from the United States, Department of State on March 18, 2015, in which we were asked to review fifteen (15) documents that originated with NGA, for equities under litigation.

After a careful review of the documents, National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) subject matter experts have determined that the documents contained NGA equities and may be released in part with some information being withheld because it is classified and is protected from release under FOIA exemptions (b)(1)1.4(c). Exemption (b)(1)1.4(c) allows for the withholding of information that is relevant to intelligence activities (including covert action), intelligence sources or methods or cryptology.


Also, we are withholding information under FOIA Exemption (b)(3), which incorporates nondisclosure provisions contained in other Federal statutes. In this case, the Federal statute which prevents disclosure is 10 U.S.C. §424 which exempts from disclosure organizational and personnel information for DIA, NRO, and NGA.

Appeals to this determination should be made in writing within 60 days from the date of this letter and sent to the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency, Freedom of Information/Privacy Act Program Office, Mail Stop N81-SISCS, 7500 GEOINT Drive, Springfield, VA 22150. The requester should reference FOIA litigation number 2015-LIT-00004 in the appeal, detailing their reasons for reconsideration and include a copy of this letter.

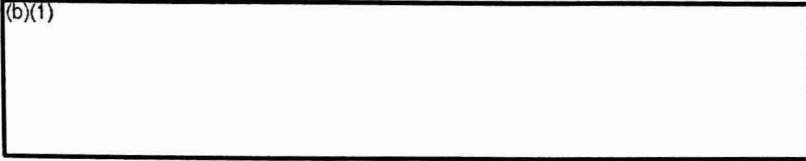

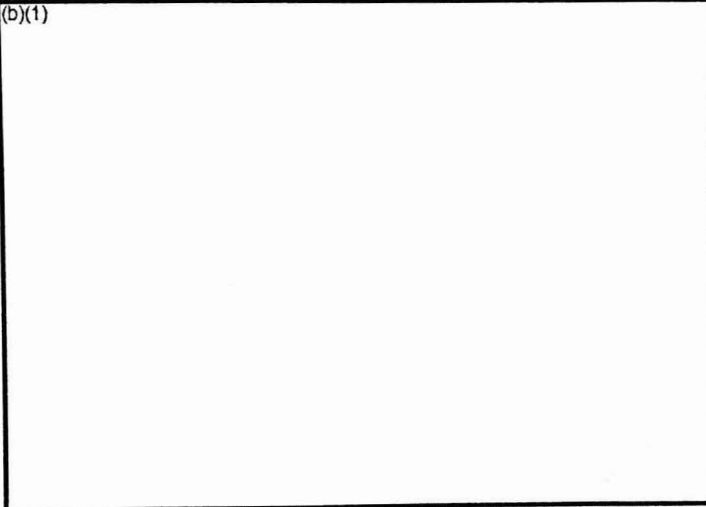

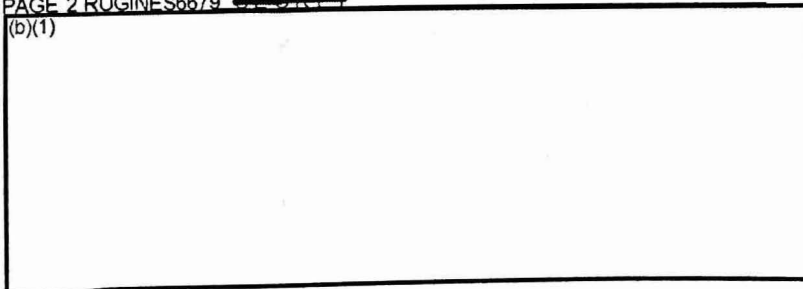
