1. ON MALAUGUST, FOLLOWING THE WEEKLY CABINET MEETING,

FINANCE MINISTER N G O N SANANIKONE DOMMENTED THAT THE

MERTING OF THE VIENTIANE SIDE LEADERS ON AUGUST WAS
EVIDENCE OF DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER L E U A M INSISIENGMAY'S
INTENTION TO FOCUS THESE MEETINGS ON ISSUES LIKELY TO BE
DISCUSSED: AT CABINET MEETINGS. NGON SAID THAT ONLY VIENTIANE SIDE CABINET MEMBERS WERE INVITED AND THAT THERE WERE
NO REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE LAO ARMED FORCES (FAR) OR THE
JOINT NATIONAL POLITICAL COUNCIL (JNPC) PRESENT.

REPORTED ON THE LIKELIHOOD THAT THE UNREST HOULD SPREAD TO ALL MINISTRIES AND THAT SUCH PROTESTS, IF LEFT UNCONTROLLED.

MOULD SERIOUSLY THREATEN THE STABILITY OF THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT OF NATIONAL UNION (PGNU). NGON SAID THAT PHENG RECOMMENDED, WITH ALL PRESENT AGREEING, THAT DURING THE LAO PATRIOTIC FRONT (LPF) JOIN THE VIENTIANE SIDE IN ISSUING A DECLARATION, ON BEHALF OF THE THO SIDES, URGING CIVIL SERVANTS TO CHANNEL THEIR GRIEVANCES AND PROTESTS VIA THEIR GESPECTIVE MINISTRIES AND TO REFRAIN FROM DEMONSTRATING OR

COMMITTING ACTS WHICH WOULD UPSET CURRENT EFFORTS BY THE TWO SIDES TO ACHIEVE NATIONAL UNION AND RECONCILIATION.

PARTICULARLY WHILE THE PRIME MINISTER IS ABSENT FROM THE COUNTRY. NGON SAID THAT THE MATTER WAS, IN FACT, RAISED AT THE AUGUST CABINET MEETING BUT THAT THE LPF REFUSED TO ISSUE SUCH A DECLARATION ON BEHALF OF THE TWO SIDES.

INSTEAD, THE CABINET AGREED THAT A SIMILAR STATEMENT WOULD BE ISSUED BY SECRETARY OF STATE FOR INFORMATION O U D A Y SOUVANNAVONG TO THE PRESS ON BEHALF OF THE PGNU. THE STATEMENT WOULD STRESS THAT CIVIL SERVANTS SHOULD REFRAIN FROM DISRUPTING CURRENT EFFORTS OF THE GOVERNMENT TO ACHIEVE PEACE DURING THE ABSENCE OF THE PRIME MINISTER.

3. ACCORDING TO NGON, PHENG NEXT REPORTED ON THE
SITUATION WITHIN THE POLICE FORCE, PHENG SAID THAT HE HAD
APPOINTED (CHAO) S I H A R A T H PHASOUK AS AD INTERIM DIRECTOR
OF THE NATIONAL POLICE UNTIL CURRENT PROBLEMS ARE RESOLVED.
PHENG STRESSED THAT ALTHOUGH THE STRIKE HAD BEEN CONFINED
TO THE TRAFFIC POLICE, THERE ARE INNUMERABLE GRIEVANCES
AMONG POLICE OFFICERS AND MEN THROUGHOUT THE POLICE FORCE
AND THAT A TOTAL MEDRGANIFATION OF THE POLICE FORCE IS NOW

CALLED FOR. PHENS SAID THAT HE IS CURRENTLY WORKING ON A REORGANIZATION PLAN WHICH HE WILL SUBMIT TO THE CABINET. NGON COMMENTED THAT HE WOULD OBJECT TO THE NOMINATION OF SIHARATH AS POLICE DIRECTOR AND WOULD HAVE TO TAKE ISSUE WITH THE NOMINATION IF IT IS PRESENTED TO THE CABINET. PHENG SAID THAT THE CURRENT APPOINTMENT WAS TEMPORARY.

OVER THE PRISONER/(POW) EXCHANGE QUESTION, PARTICULARLY CONCERNING
THE NORTH VIETNAMESE (NVA). NGON COMPLAINED THAT PRIOR TO
ANY AGREEMENT OF THIS NATURE, S D U K A N VILAYSAN, VIENTIANE
SIDE CHIEF DELEGATE TO THE JOINT COMMISSION TO IMPLEMENT
THE AGREEMENT (JCIA), SHOULD CONSULT WITH THE ENTIRE VIENTIANE
SIDE LEADERSHIP BEFORE COMMITTING HIMSELF.

SOUKAN CAME UNDER ATTACK FOR HIS AGREEMENT WITH LPF REPRESENTATIVES ON THE REPATRIATION OF POW'S TO BE HELD IN SEPTEMBER BECAUSE HE HAD MADE THE AGREEMENT WITHOUT PRIOR CONSULATION WITH HIS VIENTIANE SIDE CONFERES. AND BECAUSE HE HAD AGREED TO INCLUDE NVA POW'S IN

THE EXCHANGE. THE VIENTIANE SIDE ARGUED THAT NVA PRISONERS SHOULD BE HELD UNTIL THE HANDI GOVERNMENT ACKNOWLEDGES THEIR STATUS AS NVA TROOPS AND AGREES TO THEIR REPATRIATION. TROOPS WOULD ALSO SERVE AS AN ARGUING POINT FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL NVA TROOPS FROM LAGS. THERE ARE LIKEWISE HUMANITARIAN REASONS WHY ALL THESE PRISONERS SHOULD NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE EXCHANGE, INASHUCH AS SOME WERE RALLIERS TO THE VIENTIANE GOVERNMENT WHILE OTHERS HAD MADE STATEMENTS DURING THEIR IMPRISONMENT ON THEIR STATUS AS NVA TROOPS. IF SUCH PRISONERS ARE EXCHANGED AND SENT BACK TO NORTH VIETNAM BY THE LPF, THEY MAY BE KILLED. SOUKAN DEFENDED HIMSELF ON THE GROUNDS THAT THE JCIA IS COEQUAL WITH THE PGNU AND THE JNPC AND THAT HE, AS THE VIENTIANE SIDE CHIEF JCIA REPRESENTA-TIVE, HAS THE RIGHT TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITHOUT THE CONCURRENCE OF EITHER HIS COLLEAGUES IN THE PGNU OR THE JNPC.) ACCORDING TO NGON. PHENG SUPPORTED THE FORMER ON THIS MATTER. SPECIFICALLY, NGON, SAID THAT ON THE MATTER OF RETURNING NVA PON'S, THE INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS SHOULD BE ASKED TO INTERVIEW THE POW'S TO DETERMINE WHETHER THEY WANT TO RETURN TO NORTH VIETNAM , SOUTH VIETNAM OR ELSEWHERE, IN: SECA

ACCORDANCE WITH INTERNATION LAW. SOUKAN AGREED TO REVIEW THIS MATTER AT THE NEXT JCIA SESSION.

SOUKAN'S AGREEMENT WITH LPF JCIA CHIEF DELEGATE S O T H PHETRASY
ON PLACING JOINT POLICE (JPF) PERSONNEL WITHIN THE AIRPORT
GROUNDS. NGON SAID THAT SINCE IT IS AN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.
FOREIGNERS, ON ARRIVING AT THE AIRPORT, RECEIVE AN UNFAVORABLE
IMPRESSION OF THE PGNU WHEN THEY ARE CONFRONTED BY LPF SOLDIERS
CARRYING AK-47'S. SOUKAN SAID THAT JPF POSTS WERE LARGELY CONFINED
TO AREAS OUTSIDE THE TERMINAL. NEVERTHELESS, NGON SAID, HE HAD RECEIVED
COMPLAINTS ABOUT THE PRESENCE OF LPF PERSONNEL WITHIN THE TERMINAL AND WOULD LIKE TO REQUEST, FOR THE LAST TIME, THAT
MAJOR ISSUES SUCH AS THIS ONE FIRST BE CLEARED WITH THE VIENTIANE
SIDE. ALL PRESENT AGREED IN PRINCIPLE.

AT THE UN, THE THO SIDES REACH UNANIMOUS AGREEMENT ON ISSUES
PRESENTED BEFORE STATING AN OPINION OR CASTING A VOTE. SHOULD
THE DELEGATION FAIL TO REACH UNANIMOUS AGREEMENT, THE DELEGATION
SHOULD REFRAIN FROM PARTICIPATING IN THE DEBATE OR VOTE. ALL
AGREED HITH TIANETHONE'S SUGGESTION.

- 7. TIANETHONE ALSO MADE A REPORT ON THE REQUEST OF THE FAMILY OF P H O U M I NOSAVAN FOR LAO GOVERNMENT AUTHORIZATION TO TAKE HIM FROM SONGKHLA TO BANGKOK FOR TREATMENT. THOSE PRESENT AGREED THAT IF THE THAI GOVERNMENT JUDGES THAT IT IS PROPER AND NECESSARY, IT MAY AUTHORIZE HIM TO GO TO BANGKOK FOR TREATMENT.

- SEEKING MISSIONS, THE VIENTIANE SIDE MUST BE CAREFUL THAT IT
  NOT BE LULLED INTO EXPECTING TOO MUCH FROM SOCIALIST COUNTRIES. NGON REPORTED THAT SO FAR ONLY PROPAGANDA HAS RESULTED
  FROM THE PROMISE OF LARGE-SCALE ASSISTANCE FROM SOCIALIST
  COUNTRIES, NGON SAID THAT HE REMAINS UNIMPRESSED BY SOTH'S
  EFFORTS, CALLING ATTENTION TO SOTH'S HAVING PROCRASTINATED
  A GREAT DEAL IN FORMING HIS DELEGATIONS AND IN DRAWING UP
  LISTS OF REQUIREMENTS. NGON ADDED THAT ANY ASSISTANCE HOULD
  BENEFIT LAOS, HOWEVER SMALL, BUT THAT HE WISHES TO COUNSEL
  CAUTION ON THE PART OF THE VIENTIANE SIDE IN THIS MATTER.
- ACCORDING TO NGON, ASKED LEUAM WHETHER THE PRESENT GROUP WOULD BE EXPANDED TO INCLUDE SELECTED FAR OFFICIALS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF THE POLITICAL PARTIES. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DECLARATION ISSUED ON THE FORMATION OF THE VIENTIANE SIDE. KMAMKING NOTED THAT ON MILITARY AND POLITICAL ISSUES, THIS SMALL GROUP, NOT ELECTED BY THE PEOPLE. CANNOT EXPECT TO REPRESENT FAR AND THE POLITICAL PARTIES. LEUAM RESPONDED

THAT FOR THE TIME BEING, PARTICULARLY DURING THE ABSENCE OF THE PRIME MINISTER. IT WOULD NOT BE ADVISABLE TO EXPAND THE PRESENT COMMITTEE TO INCLUDE THESE OTHER GROUPS. LEUAM SUGGESTED THAT THE MATTER BE POSTPONED UNTIL A LATER. UNSPECIFIED DATE. THE MATTER WAS NOT FURTHER DISCUSSED.
