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END SUMMARY.

- JOINT COMMISSION TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENT (JCIA) WAS HELD. THE FIRST MATTER FOR DISCUSSION WAS THE PLANTING OF DEMARCATION POSTS. LAO PATRIOTIC FRONT (LPF) CHIEF DELEGATE S O T H PHETRASY PROPOSED DISCUSSION OF FIXING NEUTRAL AREAS BETWEEN OPPOSING FORCES AT HOT POINTS IN MILITARY REGION (MR) III. IT WAS DECIDED TO SEND A MOBILE TEAM TO THE AREA TO IMPLEMENT THIS DECISION.
- 2. SOTH SUGGESTED THAT POSTS BE QUICKLY PLANTED IN THE AREA

 OF NONG SONG HONG (UNLOCATED) AND KOUAH PHAVANG (UNLOCATED) AND

 VIENTIANE SIDE CHIEF DELEGATE SOUK AN VILAYSAN AGREED. SOUKAN

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SAID THAT HE HAD SENT A LETTER PROTESTING THE VIOLATIONS OF THE AGREEMENT IN THE AREA OF PHOU SOUNG AND NA NAN (TG 2936) IN MR II AND SAID THAT HE WOULD AGREE TO HAVE THE POST PLANTED HALF-WAY BETWEEN PHOU SOUNG AND NA NAN. THERE WAS NO FINAL AGREE-MENT ON THIS MATTER.

- SOTH URGED THAT THE VIENTIANE SIDE QUICKLY AND QUIETLY REMOVE THE SIGN OVER THE VIENTIANE MUNICIPAL GARRISON SINCE THE ROYAL ORDINANCE DIRECTING THIS ACTION SOTH STATED THAT HE DID NOT AGREE HAS ALREADY BEEN ISSUED. THAT A CEREMONY SHOULD BE HELD AT THE TIME OF REMOVAL. SOUKAN REPLIED THAT A COPY OF THE ORDINANCE WAS IN VIENTIANE SIDE MILITARY CHANNELS AND THAT THE SIGN WOULD BE REMOVED IN THE NEAR FUTURE.
- SOTH REQUESTED THAT THE VIENTIANE SIDE TAKE IMMEDIATE STEPS TO ESTABLISH THE CAMP OF THE VIENTIANE SIDE PROTECTIVE MILITARY FORCE LPMF). SOUKAN REPLIED THAT IF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE DID NOT HAVE THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO PURCHASE THE LAND FOR THE PMF CAMP, THE "INISTER OF DEFENSE WOULD BE REQUESTED TO ALLOW THE VIENTIANE SIDE TO USE THE CIVIC ACTION PROPERTY AT BAN AMONE (UNLOCATED) FOR THE PMF CAMP.

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NO DECISION WAS REACHED ON THE MATTER.

- AND THE DESIRABILITY OF HAVING JCIA REPRESENTATIVES GO
 WITH THE PLANNED GOVERNMENT DELEGATION TO THAKHEK, SOUKAN
 SAID HE HAD ALREADY ASKED VIENTIANE SIDE JCIA DELEGATE
 L O U N SISOUNOL TO BE PREPARED TO GO TO THAKHEK AND HE
 SUGGESTED THAT LPF DELEGATE P R A D I T H THIENGHAM GOTTOO.
 THIS WAS AGREED TO.
- ON THE RESETTLEMENT OF REFUGEES AND THE DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED IN GETTING SUFFICIENT PLANES. IT WAS MENTIONED THAT THE RED CRUSS WAS NOT PARTICIPATING IN THE REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT AND IT WAS DECIDED TO INVITE THE RED CROSS
- 7. SOUKAN RAISED THE SUBJECT OF THE WITHDRAWAL

 OF FOREIGN TROOPS FROM LASS. BOTH SIDES AGREED TO SET

 UP JOINT MOBILE UNITS WHICH WOULD INSPECT LOCATIONS SUBJECT

 TO THE APPROOVAL OF THE JCIA. VIENTIANE AND LUANG PRABANG

 WILL BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. SOTH STATED THAT HE WAS

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VERY SUSPICIOUS OF THE PRESENC OF THAI AND U.S. TROOPS

IN THESE THO CITIES. THE MATTER WAS ASSIGNED TO A SUB
COMMITTEE TO DRAFT. AN AGREEMENT ON INSPPECTION.

COMMENT: THIS PROBABLY WILL NIT INVOLVE A SEARCH OF FOREIGNERS'

HOMES AND THE PRINCIPLE OF DIPLOMATIC IMMUNITY WILL BE

MAINTAINED.

ACTION (MIA) AND SAID THAT THE VIENTIANE SIDE WANTED TO KNOW
THE NAMES OF THOSE PERSONS STILL ALIVE AND DETAINED
BY THE LPF, THOSE PERSONS STILL ALIVE HHO HAVE BEEN RELEASED
TO LIVE IN CONTROLLED AREAS OF THE LPF, THOSE PERSONS WHO ARE
STILL ALIVE AND WHO HAVE CHOSEN TO LIVE WITH THE LPF, AND THOSE
PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN KILLED AND THE PLACES WHERE THEIR BODIES
HAVE BEEN BURIED. SOUKAN EXPLAINED THAT THERE ARE EXPERTS
IN IDENTIFICATION OF BODIES WHO USED TO WORK IN LAOS AND WHO
CAN IDENTIFY PEOPLE ON THE BASIS OF A SKELETON. SOTH REPLIED
THAT THE LPF WOULD ATTEMPT TO COLLECT THE NAMELISTS REQUESTED
BUT STATED THAT HE HAS OPPOSED TO FOREIGN EXPERTS COMING INTO
LAOS AND CHECKING THE BONES OF THE DECEASED BEACUSE HE WAS
AFRAID THAT THEY WOULD ALSO INTERFERE IN OTHER AFFAIRS

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OF LAOS. SOTH STATED THAT HE DID NOT BELIEVE IN THE ABILITY OF EXPERTS TO MAKE IDENTIFICATIONS AND THAT HE WAS ABSOLUTELY OPPOSED TO AMERICAN INTERFERENCE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF LAOS. IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE TWO MAN SUB-COMMITTEE OF P H A O BUNNAPHOL AND A R Y A PHIMMASSONE SHOULD STUDY THE MIA QUESTION IN MORE DETAIL.

9. THE NEXT MATTER DISCUSSED WAS THE VIOLATION OF
LAO AIRSPACE IN ATTOPEU PROVINCE. COMMENT:
DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER P H O U M I VONGVICHIT HAD FORWARDED
TO SOTH AND SOUKAN COPIES OF THE PRIME MINISTER'S LETTER ON

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THIS SUBJECT ASKING FOR A JCIA INVESTIGATION.) SOUKAN SAID

THE BEST WAY TO RESOLVE THE QUESTION WAS TO SEND A JOINT

MOBILE TEAM TO ATTOPEU IMMEDIATELY TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION.

COMMENT: THE VIENTIANE SIDE HAD DECIDED THIS WAS

THE MOST EFFECTIVE STEP AND HOULD PUT THE LPF ON THE DEFENSIVE

BECAUSE OF ITS LOCATION IN THE AREA OF SOUTH LAGS CONTROLLED

BY THE LPF OR THE NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY.) SOTH OPPOSED

SENDING A TEAM AT THIS TIME SUGGESTING AS A FIRST STEP THE

MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS SHOULD BE ASKED TO QUERY THE

SOUTH VIETNAMESE EMBASSY TO SEE IF THEY WOULD CONFIRM THE

THAKHEK NOW BEING HELD UNDER JCIA CUSTODY AT THE

JOINT HEADQUARTERS OF THE JOINT MILITARY FORCE BE GIVEN MORE

FREEDOM. SOTH SAID THAT THEY SHOULD BE ALLOHED TO COME

AND GO IN THE DAYTIME AND SHOULD HAVE MORE FREEDOM IN

RECEIVING GUESTS. SOTH COMMENTED THAT S I S A V A N G

CHANTHEPHA, LEADER OF THE 21 ORGANIZATIONS, HAD VISITED

HIM ON BEHALF OF THE PRISONERS. SOUKAN REPLIED THAT THE

PRISONERS WERE RECEIVING GOOD CARE.
