

- 1. ON JANUARY 1975 THE PLENARY SESSION OF THE JOINT COMMISSION TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENT (JCIA) WAS HELD AT LAGS PATRIOTIC FRONT (LPF) HEADQUARTERS AT PHONE XAY UNDER THE JOINT CHAIRMANSHIP OF VIENTIANE SIDE CHIEF DELEGATE S O U K A N VILAYSAN AND PLF CHIEF DELEGATE S O T H PHETRASY.
- 2. SOTH, AS CHIEF OF THE HOST DELEGATION, PROPOSED DISCUSSION
 OF FIVE TOPICS: THE RETURN OF REFUGEES TO THEIR VILLAGES; THE EIGHT
 DEMONSTRATION LEADERS FROM THAKHEK, ARRESTED BY THE VIENTIANE SIDE AND
 BEING HELD IN SAVANNAKHET, WHO, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DECISION OF THE
 PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT OF NATIONAL UNION (PGNU), ARE TO BE TURNED OVER
 TO THE JCIA; WITHDRAWAL OF VIENTIANE SIDE TROOPS FROM THE PREFECTURE OF
 VIENTIANE; DESIGNATION OF HOT POINTS AND THE OPENING OF LINES OF COMMUNICATION FROM BAN HOUE! SAI TO LUANG PRABANG AND FROM PAKSANE TO
 THAKHEK; AND MISCELLANEOUS QUESTIONS.
- 3. SOUKAN ALSO PROPOSED DISCUSSION OF FIVE TOPICS: THE EIGHT DEMONSTRATION LEADERS FROM THAKHEK; STUDY OF THE MISSING IN ACTION (MIA) QUESTION; WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN TROOPS FROM LAOS; THE REFUGEE QUESTION; AND THE DESIGNATION OF HOT POINTS AND THE UPENING OF ROADS.
- 4. AFTER SOME DISCUSSION BOTH SIDES AGREED, AT LPF REQUEST, TO COVER THE REFUGEE QUESTION FIRST. FOLLOWING REPORTS BY BOTH

SIDES. THE JCIA DECIDED THAT A TEST FLIGHT WOULD BE MADE ON 24 JANUARY TO PHONE SAVANH IN THE LPF ZONE ON THE PLAINE DES JARRES, WITH TWO HELICOPTERS PROVIDED BY THE LAG ARMED FORCES (FAR). AID LAG (RAL) OBSERVERS AND POSSIBLY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CIVIL AVIATION DEPARTMENT WILL GO ALONG TO DETERMINE WHETHER RAL C-46 AND C-47 AIRCRAFT CAN LAND AT PHONE SAVANH AIRFIELD. IT WAS ALSO DECIDED THAT IF NO TECHNICAL PROBLEMS ARISE TO CAUSE DELAYS, THE FIRST RAL FLIGHT TO PHONE SAVANH, WITH REFUGEES ON BOARD, SHOULD TAKE RAL HAS AGREED TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR PLACE ON 27 JANUARY MOVING THE REFUGEES FROM RESETTLEMENT VILLAGES TO WATTAY AIRPORT, RAL DOES NOT AGREE, HOW-AND FROM WATTAY BY PLANE TO PHONE SAVANH. THE JCIA WILL STUDY EVER. TO PROVIDE FOOD SUPPLIES FOR THE REFUGEES. THE QUESTION AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE SUM OF MONEY NEEDED TO THE VIENTIANE OFFICE OF THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR THE JCIA ESTIMATES THAT THO DAYS' FOOD SUPPLY WILL BE REFUGEES. NEEDED FOR RETURN BY AIR AND FIVE DAYS' FOOD SUPPLY FOR RETURN BY LAND.

DURING THE DISCUSSION OF HOT POINTS, IT WAS DECIDED THAT ON 28 JANUARY & CEASEFIRE MOBILE TEAM HOULD BE SENT TO PHOU SONG-NANANE (TG 2936). THE TEAM WILL LATER TRAVEL TO THAKHEK. WHILE LOUN SISSUNCE AND PHA O BOUNNAPHOL WERE IN THAKHEK ON

18 JANUARY, THEY EXAMINED THE AREA AND MADE THE NECESSARY DECISIONS REGARDING THE PLANTING OF THE STAKE. S O M B O U N VONGPHRACHANH AND PHAO WILL STUDY THE MATTER AND PREPARE THE NECESSARY PAPERHORK IN VIENTIANE PRIOR TO THEIR TRAVEL AS A TEAM TO THAKHEK.

- THERE WAS DISCUSSION OF OPENING LINES OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN BAN HOUET SAT AND LUANG PRABANG. THE LPF DELEGATION SAID THAT LOCAL AUTHORITIES ARE DISCUSSING THE MATTER.
- 7. THE UCIA DISCUSSED THE DISPOSITION OF THE EIGHT DEMONSTRATORS ARRESTED IN THAKHEK. IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE JCIA SHOULD ACCEPT THEM IN LINE WITH THE PGNU'S REQUEST. IT WAS FURTHER DECIDED. HOWEVER. THAT THE QUESTION SHOULD BE STUDIED BEFORE THE EIGHT ARE MOVED TO VIENTIANE. LOUN AND PRADITH THIENGTHAM WILL ACT AS A SUB-COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE QUESTION AND DRAW UP A JOINT COMMUNIQUE. THE LPF DELEGATION WANTS TO DISCUSS AND REVIEW NOT ONLY THE CHARGES MADE AGAINST THE EIGHT BUT ALSO THE CHARGES MADE BY THE EIGHT AGAINST CIVILIAN AND MILITARY OFFICIALS IN THAKHEK. THE VIENTIANE SIDE DELEGATION REFUSED AND AGREED ONLY TO AN INVESTIGATION OF WHETHER OR NOT THE EIGHT HAD COMMITTED WRONGFUL ACTS DURING THE DEMONSTRATION.
- DURING DISCUSSION OF THE WITHDRAWAL OF VIENTIANE SIDE TROOPS FROM THE PREFECTURE OF VIENTIANE. THE LPF ASKED WHETHER THE LAND FOR

THE VIENTIANE SIDE PROTECTIVE MILITARY FORCE (PMF) CAMP HAD BEEN PURCHASED. THE VIENTIANE SIDE DELEGATION REPLIED THAT IT HAD NOT AND THAT LOCAL LANDOWNERS HAD BEEN ATTEMPTING TO RAISE THE PRICE OF THEIR LAND. IT WAS AGREED THAT THE VIENTIANE NEUTRALIZATION SUBCOMMITTEE SHOULD REVIEW THE QUESTION WITH THE PREFECTURE OF VIENTIANE, IN CHARGE OF NEGOTIATIONS WITH LOCAL LANDOWNERS.

9. DURING THE DISCUSSION OF THE MIA ISSUE, THE VIENTIANE SIDE

DELEGATES POINTED OUT TO THEIR LPF COUNTERPARTS THAT FAR HAD FURNISHED

COMPLETE LISTS OF ALL MISSING VIENTIANE SIDE TROOPS AS WELL AS FOREIGN

TROOPS LISTED AS MISSING. IT WAS ALSO NOTED THAT THE FOREIGN TROOPS

HAD BEEN IDENTIFIED AS TO THE DAY, DATE AND LOCATION OF THE ACTION

IN WHICH THEY WERE INVOLVED OR THE AIRCRAFT CRASH SITES. THESE LISTS,

THE LPF DELEGATION WAS TOLD. SHOULD BE SUFFICIENT IN ACCOUNTING FOR

MANY OF THE MISSING. IF THEY ARE DEAD. THE LPF SHOULD BE ABLE TO

PROVIDE BURIAL OR CRASH SITES SO THAT REMAINS MAY BE RECOVERED. THE

ISSUE WAS PRESENTED AS BEING OF EXTREME INTEREST, NOT ONLY TO THE

FOREIGNERS BUT ALSO TO THE NIDOWS AND CHILDREN OF THE MISSING. THE

VIENTIANE SIDE DELEGATION NOTED THAT THE LPF HAD NOT AS YET PROVIDED

COMPLETE LISTS OF ALL RELATIVES AND THEIR DISPOSITION, WHEREAS FAR

HAS FURNISHED COMPLETE LISTS OF BOTH LPF AND NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY



11. SOTH RAISED THE MATTER OF THE PROLIFERATION OF LEAFLETS ON
THE STREETS OF VIENTIANE. HE SAID THAT MANY FACTIONS WERE PRODUCING
THESE LEAFLETS, SOME OF WHICH ARE EXTREMELY INSULTING TO INDIVIDUALS,
INCLUDING THE PRIME MINISTER AND JOINT NATIONAL POLITICAL COUNCIL
CHAIRMAN PRINCE S O U P H A N O U V O N G. BOTH SIDES AGREED TO HAVE
THE JOINT POLICE FORCE (JPF) OF BOTH SIDES HANDLE THE MATTER BY
ARRESTING ANYONE CAUGHT DISTRIBUTING SLANDEROUS LEAFLETS. PRADITH
REMARKED THAT HE HAD PERSONALLY SEEN PERSONS IN FAR JEEPS DISTRIBUTING

LEAFLETS IN THE EARLY-MORNING HOURS. THE JPF SHOULD USE WHATEVER FORCE MAY BE NEEDED, PRADITH ADDED, INCLUDING FIRING AT THE TIRES OF VEHICLES BEING SO USED, TO PUT A STOP TO THE LEAFLETS. THE VIENTIANE SIDE DELEGATION REPLIED THAT HANDLING THE MATTER IN SUCH A WAY WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE INASMUCH AS SOMEONE MIGHT BE ACCIDENTLLY KILLED AND THE POPULACE FRIGHTENED BY GUNFIRE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE NIGHT.

SOUKAN PROMISED TO COOPERATE IN THE EFFORT TO HALT THE LEAFLET DISTRIBUTION, ALSO PROMISING THE FULL COOPERATION OF THE VIENTIANE SIDE JPF IN THE MATTER.
