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FRANCE, MAI VAN ((BO)), HOSTED A RECEPTION AT THE SRV EMBASSY IN PARIS ON 12 MARCH 1984 AT HHICH THREE PRINCIPAL TOPICS HERE DISCUSSED: THE VIETNAMESE ATTITUDE TOHARD THE SINO-SOVIET NORMALIZATION TALKS, THE RECENT VISIT OF A UNITED STATES (U.S.) DELEGATION TO HANOI, AND THE SRV REACTION TO THE DEFECTION OF A VIETNAMESE PERFORMER IN HEST BERLIN. GUESTS AT THE RECEPTION INCLUDED THE MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDIUM AND OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE ASSOCIATION OF VIETNAMESE RESIDENTS OF FRANCE (AVF), AND LOCAL MEMBERS OF THE VIETNAMESE COMMUNIST PARTY. ALSO PRESENT FROM THE SRV EMBASSY HERE COUNSELOR LE VAN ((THAN)) AND ATTACHE NGUYEN HUU ((NGHIEP)).

2. ON THE SUBJECT OF SINO-SOVIET NORMALIZATION TALKS, NGHIEP DISCLOSED THAT THE CHINESE HAVE CONSISTENTLY INSISTED THAT: THE SOVIET UNION CEASE ALL AID TO VIETNAM; VIETNAMESE TROOPS BE HITHDRAWN FROM KAMPUCHEA; AND ALL AID TO THE ((HENG)) SAMRIN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KAMPUCHEA GOVERNMENT IN PHNOM PENH BE HALTED. NGHIEP CONTINUED THAT THE SRV IS CERTAIN THAT THE USSR HILL NEVER CHANGE ITS ATTITUDE TOWARD VIETNAM, BUT CHINESE INTRANSIGENCE CLEARLY SHOWS THE PLAN FORMULATED BY BEIJING, NAMELY, TO DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO ATTACK VIETNAM, AND TO STRENGTHEN THE DEMOCRATIC KAMPUCHEA (DK) FACTION SO THAT IT CAN ASSAULT PHNOM PENH AND REGAIN CONTROL IN KAMPUCHEA. FOR THIS REASON, NGHIEP CONCLUDED, A MEETING BETHEEN THE NEW CONSTRUCTION OF THE PLANT OF T CHEA. FOR THIS REASON, NGHIEP CONCLUDED, A MEETING BETHEEN THE NEW SOVIET LEADERS AND A VIETNAMESE DELEGATION IS IMPERATIVE. HE PREDICTED THAT A HIGH RANKING VIETNAMESE DELEGATION HOULD VISIT MOSCON EITHER DURING PRESIDENT RONALD ((REAGAN))'S VISIT TO CHINA, OR IN MAY 1984, OR ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE OCTOBER REVOLUTION.

CUMMENT: IT APPEARS THAT THE VIETNAMESE LEADERS ARE NOT HAPPY WITH THE NEGOTIATIONS BETHEEN CHINA AND THE USSR ON NORMALIZATION OF RELATIONS.)

3. AMBASSADOR BO STATED THAT A U.S. DELEGATION HAD RECENTLY VISITED HANOI SEEKING INFORMATION ON U.S. SERVICEMEN MISSING IN ACTION (MIA) DURING THE HAR IN VIETNAM. BO CLAIMED THAT SRY FOREIGN MINISTER NGUYEN CO ((THACH)) PROVIDED THE AMERICANS HITH NEH INFORMATION AND THAT THE THO SIDES REACHED AN AGREEMENT TO STUDY THIS SUBJECT FURTHER. COMMENT: THE THO SRV PUBLICATIONS, "NHAN DAN" AND "QUAN DOI NHAN DAN," BOTH MENTIONED THE VISIT OF THE U.S. DELEGATION AND BOTH STRESSED THAT THACH RECEIVED THE DELEGATION LED BY THE U.S. DEPUTY ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF DEFENSE.) BO CONTINUED THAT THIS WAS THE FIRST TIME IN SEVERAL YEARS THAT SUCH A HIGH RANKING DELEGATION HAD BEEN SENT TO HANOI. HE ALSO NOTED THAT THIS VISIT FOLLOHED A MEETING OF THE FOREIGN MINISTERS OF VIETNAM, LAOS AND KAMPUCHEA WHICH RESULTED IN A COMMUNIQUE STATING: "THE THREE COUNTRIES ARE PREPARED TO TREAT THE QUESTION OF MISSING U.S. SOLDIERS WITH THE U.S. GOVERNMENT AS SOON AS THE LATTER SHOWS AN ATTITUDE OF COOPERATION AND RENOUNCES ITS HOSTILE POLICIES."

HOSTILE POLICIES." THE LATTER SHOWS AN ATTITUDE OF COOPERATION AND RENOUNCES ITS HOSTILE POLICIES." HOSTILE COMMENT: THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THAT LAOS AND KAMPUCHEA AGREED TO JOIN THE SRY IN COMMENTING ON THIS SUBJECT.) A MEMBER OF THE AUDIENCE ASKED BO HHAT HE THOUGHT ABOUT THE DECLARATION OF THE HEAD OF THE LEAGUE OF FAMILIES CONCERNED WITH THE MIA THAT "FUTURE RELATIONS BETHEEN THE U.S. AND VIETNAM HILL BE GOOD AND FRUITFUL." BO CAUTIONED THAT THIS HEAD, A HOMAN, HAS THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE AMERICAN VETERANS OF VIETNAM AND NOT AN OFFICIAL MEMBER OF THE U.S. DELEGATION, BUT HER REMARKS SHOWED THAT THERE IS NO LONGER ANY ANIMOSITY BETWEEN THE PEOPLE OF THE THO NATIONS. BO STATED, HOMEVER, THAT SO LONG AS THE PRESENT U.S. ADMINISTRATION, ALLIED WITH CHINA, REMAINS TOTALLY HOSTILE TO VIETNAM, THERE IS LITTLE HOPE FOR IMPROVING RELATIONS BETHEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE THO NATIONS.

4. BO THEN BRIEFLY PRESENTED THE SRY VERSION OF THE EVENTS WHICH TOOK PLACE DURING THE MID-FEBRUARY 1984 VISIT OF A VIETNAMESE ARTISTIC TROUPE TO HEST BERLIN. BO CLAIMED THAT WHEN THE VIETNAMESE GROUP ARRIVED FOR ITS PERFORMANCE AT THE COLLEGE OF ARTS THEATER,

A GANG OF VIETNAMESE REFUGEES AND FOREIGNERS ASSAULTED THE SRV ARTISTS. THREE OF THEM, MISS BACH ((TUYET)), MISS NGOC ((GIAU)), AND THANH ((DUOCI), HERE PLACED FORCIBLY IN AUTOMOBILES. THO HEST GERMAN POLICEMEN ON THE SCENE HERE POHERLESS AGAINST THE GANG OF NUMEROUS AND ARMED KIDNAPPERS. MISS GIAU MANAGED TO ESCAPE BEFORE THE AUTOMOBILE COULD DEPART. THE THO OTHERS HERE SPED AHAY TO A SECRET LOCATION, HHERE THEY HERE CONFRONTED BY A GROUP OF VIETNAMESE REACTIONARIES. THEIR CAPTORS, ALONG WITH TWO EUROPEAN JOURNALISTS, ADVISED THEM TO DEFECT AND OFFERED TO TAKE THEM IMMEDIATELY TO THE U.S. EMBASSY WHERE THEY COULD SEEK POLITICAL ASYLUM. MISS TUYET REFUSED AND DEMANDED TO BE TAKEN BACK TO THE CITY, WHERE SHE REJOINED THE OTHER VIETNAMESE PERFORMERS. BO SAID THE PLOT FAILED DUE TO THE DETERMINATION OF THE PERFORMERS. ONLY DUOC REMAINS UNACCOUNTED FOR. BO SAID THAT SRV EMBASSY HAS FILED A PROTEST WITH THE HEST GERMAN GOVERNMENT DEMANDING HIS RETURN.
