THE NEW YORK TIMES ON 8 DECEMBER
PUBLISHED AN ARTICLE CITING AN AUSTRALIAN TELEVISION REPORT THAT THE
KGB INTERROGATED U.S. POWS BETWEEN 1975 AND 1978. THE TIMES ARTICLE
STATED THAT "AGENTS" BELIEVED THE AMERICANS MIGHT HAVE BEEN KILLED
AFTER BEING RETURNED TO THE VIETNAMESE.)

2. THE GUIDANCE SAID THAT THE VIETNAMESE MFA HAS INFORMATION
INDICATING THAT THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT WILL INTERVIEW FORMER
KGB GENERAL OLEG ((KALUGIN)) AND HIS COLLEAGUES IN MOSCOW ON 18

EARLIER REPORT, IS TO GET AS MUCH PUBLICITY AS POSSIBLE FROM
THIS DENIAL AND GET OTHER NEWSPAPERS TO CARRY THE STORY.
