PLAINTIFFS' UNOPPOSED MOTIN FOR FURTHER EXTENSION  
OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO REPLY TO DEFENDANT'S  
OPPOSITION TO PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION


Come now the plaintiffs, Roger Hall and Studies Solutions Results, Inc., and moves this Court for a further two-day extension, to and including July 21, 2008, within which to reply to defendant's opposition to plaintiffs' motion for reconsideration of Magistrate Judge Facciola's ruling striking portions of the Declaration of Roger Hall. As grounds for this motion, plaintiffs state to the Court as follows:\

1. Plaintiffs' reply was due July 16, 2008.
2. Plaintiffs' just recently returned from a trip to New York City and, in addition to beginning the work on this case, had some work on other cases which had to be done. On July 16<sup>th</sup>, he informed counsel for defendant that he was going to ask for a one-day extension and she indicated that her client would not oppose it. Subsequently, after conferring with his client, it was determined that a two-day extension is necessary. Then, on the afternoon of July 17<sup>th</sup>, counsel retrieved a voice mail message from his downtown office from a lady on the 7<sup>th</sup> floor of the office building telling him that packages

addressed to him had been left at her office. This necessitated an unplanned trip downtown to retrieve the packages. They turned out to be a release of some 1,300 pages of records relevant to another of his cases in which a brief is due next week. This required a review to see whether they will have any bearing on the brief to be filed in the other case. As a result of all of this, counsel has decided it would be prudent to seek an extension until July 21, 2008 in this case.

3. Defendant does not oppose this motion.
