SUMMARY: IN LATE SEPTEMBER 1975, A FOREIGN TRAVELER WHO RECENTLY DEPARTED SAIGON SAID ABOUT 50 U.S. CITIZENS WERE BEING DETAINED IN SAIGON BY THE PROVISIONAL REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT (PRG). THE PRG HAS INITIATED A MASSIVE CAMPAIGN TO MOVE PEOPLE FROM SAIGON TO RURAL AREAS. FAMILY HEADS ARE BEING SENT FIRST, WITH THE FAMILIES TO FOLLOW ONCE A HOME HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED IN THE COUNTRYSIDE. PRG AUTHORITIES ARE USING STUDENTS TO MAKE

A DETAILED CENSUS OF SAIGON AND CHOLON. SAIGON STUDENTS ARE ALSO BEING GIVEN EXTENSIVE COMMUNIST INDOCTRINATION. DESPITE THE ISSUANCE OF NEW CURRENCY BY THE PRG, OLD GOVERNMENT OF VIETNAM (GVN) PIASTERS ARE STILL BEING ACCEPTED BY SAIGON MERCHANTS. RUMORS ABOUND IN SAIGON THAT FORMER GVN FORCES ARE CONTINUING RESISTANCE AGAINST THE PRG. END SUMMARY,

1. IN LATE SEPTEMBER 1975, A FOREIGN TRAVELER WHO RECENTLY DEPARTED SAIGON, SAID THAT ABOUT 50 U.S. CITIZENS WERE BEING DETAINED IN SAIGON BY THE PROVISIONAL REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT (PRG) AUTHORITIES IN A BUILDING KNOWN AS THE "MAXIM BUILDING". HE SAID THAT HE KNEW OF ONLY ONE AMERICAN, A CHINESE-AMERICAN FROM HONOLULU NAMED [REDACTED] WHO WAS FREE TO WALK AROUND SAIGON. THE TRAVELER SAID IT WAS POSSIBLE THAT [REDACTED] WHO HAS A VIETNAMESE WIFE AND TWO CHILDREN, WAS UNKNOWN TO PRG AUTHORITIES AS AN AMERICAN AS HE COULD EASILY PASS FOR A VIETNAMESE. [REDACTED] COMMENT: THE TRAVELER DID NOT KNOW EXACTLY HOW MANY AMERICANS ARE BEING DETAINED IN SAIGON OR UNDER WHAT CONDITIONS THEY ARE LIVING.)

[REDACTED] COMMENT: THE NAME [REDACTED] APPEARED ON A LIST OF AMERICANS CURRENTLY IN VIETNAM WHICH WAS BROUGHT OUT OF SAIGON BY EXPELLED UNITED PRESS INTERNATIONAL CORRESPONDENT [REDACTED] IN EARLY SEPTEMBER 1975.)

2. THE PRG HAS INITIATED A MASSIVE CAMPAIGN TO REMOVE PEOPLE FROM SAIGON. IN EARLY SEPTEMBER PEOPLE IN SAIGON WERE TOLD THAT THOSE WITHOUT JOBS WOULD HAVE TO MOVE TO RURAL AREAS. AS VERY FEW PEOPLE HAVE JOBS THIS ORDER COULD AFFECT THE MAJORITY OF THOSE IN SAIGON. PEOPLE WERE ALLOWED TO INDICATE WHERE THEY WOULD LIKE TO GO BUT THERE WAS NO ASSURANCE THEIR REQUESTS WOULD BE HONORED. THE PRG HAS NAMED CERTAIN AREAS TO RECEIVE THE EXCESS POPULATION FROM SAIGON ON A PRIORITY BASIS; THE FIRST OF THESE AREAS, THE BIEN HOA REGION NEAR SAIGON, HAS ALREADY FILLED ITS QUOTA OF NEW INHABITANTS AND SAIGON RESIDENTS ARE NO LONGER PERMITTED TO MOVE TO BIEN HOA. THE SECOND AREA FOR RELOCATION IS PHUOC LONG PROVINCE ALONG THE CAMBODIAN BORDER. OTHER PRIORITY RESETTLEMENT AREAS INCLUDE "TINH CUONG HA" (UNLOCATED)

(TEXT) HANOI, 3 JUNE VNA--THE DRV FOREIGN MINISTRY SPORTSMAN TODAY ISSUED A STATEMENT REFUTING RECENT MISLEADING STATEMENTS BY THE U.S.

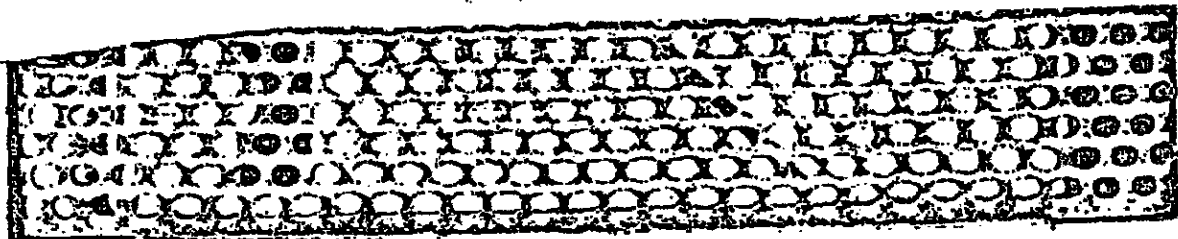
ON 29 MAY 1975, THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT STATED THAT HANOI MUST BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE AMERICAN MISSING DURING THE VIETNAM WAR.

ON 31 MAY, PHILIP MARIE, ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE, SLANDEROUSLY CHARGED THAT THE DRV GOVERNMENT HAD VIOLATED THE PARIS AGREEMENTS TO JUSTIFY THE FACT THAT THE UNITED STATES HAS NOT YET ESTABLISHED A PLAN TO CONTRIBUTE TO HEALING THE WOUNDS OF WAR AND TO REBUILDING NORTH VIETNAM.

"THE DRV GOVERNMENT FIRMLY CONDEMNS AND DENOUNCES THESE FALLACIOUS AND SLANDEROUS U.S. INTENTIONS," THE STATEMENT SAYS AND CONTINUES:

"EVERYONE KNOWS THAT THE DRV GOVERNMENT HAS IMPLEMENTED A HUMANITARIAN POLICY WHICH HAS BEEN EXPRESSED BY SUCH ACTS OF GOODWILL AS AUTHORIZING THE U.S. SIDE TO VISIT THE BURIAL SITES AND REPAIRED THE REMAINS OF THE 23 U.S. PILOTS WHO DIED DURING THEIR IMPRISONMENT IN NORTH VIETNAM. IT IS THE AMERICAN SIDE THAT VIOLATED THE PARIS AGREEMENTS AND HAMPED RESOLUTION OF THE PROBLEM OF THE MISSING. MEANWHILE, THE AMERICAN SIDE HAS OPENLY STATED THAT IT WILL NOT IMPLEMENT ARTICLE 21 OF THE AGREEMENT, WHICH STIPULATES THE U.S. IS OBLIGATED TO CONTRIBUTE TO HEALING THE WOUNDS OF WAR IN THE DRV. IT IS PLAIN THAT THE PRESENT SITUATION CONCERNING THE PROBLEM OF THE U.S. MISSING IN VIETNAM HAS BEEN CAUSED BY THE AMERICAN SIDE. THE U.S. ADMINISTRATION MUST BE HELD FULLY RESPONSIBLE."

[Redacted] THE SAIGON RESIDENT IS PROBABLY REFERRING TO THE APPROXIMATELY 50 AMERICANS AND DEPENDENTS OF U.S. CITIZENS LEFT IN SAIGON, TWO OF WHOM HAVE BEEN DETAINED BY THE COMMUNISTS. ALTHOUGH ALL ARE CIVILIANS, THE SOURCE PROBABLY USED THE VIETNAMESE TERM "PRISONERS-OF-WAR" IN REFERRING TO THE TWO AMERICAN CIVILIAN DETAINEES. THE IDENTITIES OF ALL OF THE AMERICAN CITIZENS WHO REMAINED IN SAIGON AFTER 30 APRIL 1975

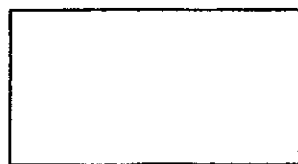

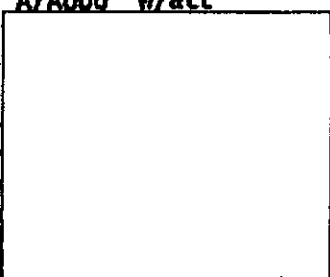

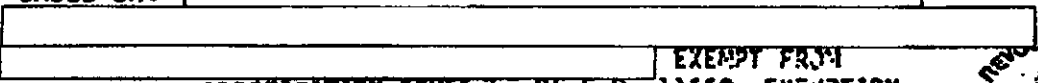
