

1. (U) The Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) referred 146 documents from the Roger Hall litigation to the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) for review. CIA's referral letter says there are only 20 documents because several were bound together as one document when DIA received the referral. Even though DIA separated them into individual documents, DIA kept them in the order received. Please review the documents and respond directly to the requester.
2. (U) DIA has reviewed the documents and recommends that the information be declassified and released to the requester with the exception of the highlighted material. DIA recommends that this information be withheld from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(1), (b)(3), and (b)(6) of the Freedom of Information Act. The applicable (b)(3) statutes are 10 U.S.C. 424 and 50 U.S.C. 403-1(i). DIA's recommended redactions are in color. CIA also made redactions, which are in black and white.
3. (U) DIA's review determined that there are other agencies' equities within the documents. DIA has noted on the inventory and on the translucent redacted copies of the documents which other agencies have equities in the documents and should review them prior to release.
4. (U) Please be advised that DIA no longer has the expertise regarding POW-MIA matters from the Vietnam War era. Even though DIA made recommended redactions, DIA completely defers to the Department of Defense's Prisoner of War-Missing Personnel Office (DPMO) for final release determination.
5. (U) Additionally, several of the documents look like they may have been sanitized and previously released. If any of these documents have been previously released, please disregard DIA's redactions from this current review. Again, DIA defers to DPMO on release determination.
