CIA'S STATUS REPORT

The Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) respectfully submits the following status report on its on-going efforts to comply with the Court's August 3, 2012 Order [Dkt. No. 186]. Pursuant to the Court's order provided at the Status Conference December 19, 2012, the CIA has been searching the Director's Area for records responsive to Item 7 of Plaintiffs' request for all records on or pertaining to any search conducted regarding any congressional committee requests pertaining to Vietnam War POW/MIAs.

It has also completed its search of the relevant electronic index for the 1,711 POW/MIA names provided by plaintiff, and has excluded the hits that are clearly not responsive. Using the results of the index search as a guide, the Agency is in the process of identifying and reviewing potentially responsive paper records contained in its archives. As part of that process, it is separating the documents into three categories consisting of records that are responsive, possibly responsive, and definitely non-responsive. The CIA anticipates that it will be able to provide the Court with the results of its "Item 7" search and the precise numbers that fall into each of the foregoing categories for the names search at the March 19, 2013 status conference, as ordered.
