
1. Plaintiffs had previously moved for an extension to and including August 16, 2013, on which the Court has not yet acted.

3. Counsel arose on the morning of August 15th thinking that he might have sufficient time and energy to complete his reply due in this case by August 16th. However, in the early afternoon he learned that Judge Beryl Howell had handed down a 163-page opinion which dealt in part with what at first glance appears to be essentially the same electronic records issue that plaintiffs have raised in this case. Additionally, plaintiffs' counsel also learned of several additional cases, not known before, which he needed to obtain and evaluate for use in his brief due in this case.

4. Defendants do not oppose this motion.
