NOTICE OF FILING

Plaintiffs Roger Hall and Studies Solutions Results, Inc. hereby give notice of the filing of Plaintiff's Local Rule 7.1(h) Statement and a proposed order.

These items were omitted from the filing of plaintiff' filing of their cross-motion for summary judgment and other relief on May 10, 2007, because as plaintiffs' undersigned counsel began to print out the copies of his brief and other supporting documents using the Hewlet-Packard LaserJet Printer II that is attached to his 1989 NEC computer so he could scan them into another computer for electronic filing with the Court, his printer began to run out of ink.

By removing the toner cartridge and shaking it vigorously, counsel was able to print out legible copies of his 45-page brief and the 15-page Hall Declaration. However, when he went to print out the Local Rule Statement, the copy became illegible and shaking the toner cartridge did not result in any improvement. See attached copy .

Because the HP II printer is outmoded and it takes a day or two to obtain toner, counsel usually orders two or three cartridges at a time to avoid the kind of situation just encountered. This time, however, he was out of toner, and because all of this took place after 11:00 p.m., he had to wait until May 11th to order new toner cartridges. Fortunately, his supplier, which informed him that it only had one cartridge on hand, was able to deliver it to his house late on the afternoon of May 11th.

PLAINTIFF/S LOCAL RULE 7.1(b) STATEMENT

Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7.1(b), plaintiffs Roger Hall ("Hall") and Studies Solutions Results, Inc., submits the following statement of material facts as to which there is no genuine dispute:

1. The CIA has not searched its operational files for records responsive to my request. Declaration of Scott A. Koch ("Koch Decl."), ¶ 1.

2. The subject of missing Prisoners of War ("POWs") and persons Missing in Action ("MIAs") from the Vietnam War has been investigated by the House Committee on MIA/POW Affairs, the Senate Committee on Intelligence, and the Senate Armed Services Committee. A report was also released by the House POW/MIA Task Force in 1994. See H. REP. REP. 103-100, 26.

3. During the Vietnam War, the Political Adviser ("POLAD") at the CIA (now known as the National Civilian Political Action Center ("NCPAC")) was the originator and/or manager of the program, tasking, and reporting. Additionally, the program was funded, and generated records concerning, the program's activities from one
