JOINT STATUS REPORT

Plaintiffs Eugene McDaniel, Carol Hrdlicka, Robert Moore, Jana Orear, Christianne O'Malley, Mark Sauter, John Zimmerlee, and the POW Investigative Project, Inc., and Defendant the National Archives and Records Administration ("NARA"), hereby provide the Court with the following Joint Status Report pursuant to the Court's Minute Order dated September 21, 2022. The former lead Plaintiff, Lois Moore, unfortunately passed away on July 24, 2021.

Plaintiffs filed an amended complaint on September 1, 2021, adding a second FOIA request submitted to NARA on May 21, 2021 and adding two additional FOIA requesters as Plaintiffs. Defendant answered the amended complaint on September 15, 2021.

Part of the records responsive to Plaintiff's first request involve records containing national security or other sensitive information (requests 28-48) which required consultation with the equity holding agencies. NARA completed processing 15 of the 16 documents that were sent out for consultation and made these records available to the plaintiff, with portions withheld under applicable FOIA exemptions. NARA is still waiting to receive a response with respect to the remaining document that is out on consultation. Searches for portions of Plaintiff's second request are ongoing. Two portions of the second request deal with archival records.

Plaintiff has received final responses with respect to those portions of the request.

NARA has also completed preliminary searches, to the extent possible, with respect to the

remaining portions of the second request which seek operational records. NARA previously

provided 2,200 pages in full in response to this request. Since the last status report, NARA has

provided an additional two tranches of releases, totaling 816 pages and 3 spreadsheets, released

in full, and 6 pages released with redactions pursuant to 5 U.S.C.§552(b)(6). In total, NARA has

provided 3,016 pages and 3 spreadsheets in full and 6 pages in part in response to the request for

operational records. The parties continue to cooperate and discuss resolution and narrowing of the

issues with regard to portions of the FOIA requests at issue without the need for Court intervention.

The parties propose to continue their discussions and the processing of the FOIA request.

Based on the foregoing, the parties do not at this time see the need for court intervention

or the setting of a briefing schedule for dispositive motions. The parties respectfully request that

they file a status report on or before February 17, 2023, to update the Court on the status of the

FOIA requests.
