**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT PARTIES' JOINT  
STATUS REPORT**

The parties jointly move this Court for an extension of time until December 1, 2016, to file their joint status report. In support of their motion for extension of time, the parties state the following:

1. On July 25, 2016, this Court entered an order lifting a partial stay of this Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) suit against defendant, the Central Intelligence Agency (“CIA”)<sup>1</sup> in light of the June 28, 2016 issuance of the U.S. House of Representatives Select Committee’s “Investigation and Report on the Terrorist Attack in Benghazi.” *See* Minute Order (July 25, 2016). On September 22, 2016, this Court directed the parties to submit a joint status report setting forth recommendations for further proceedings, *see* Minute

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<sup>1</sup> In addition to Defendant, the CIA, Plaintiffs brought this FOIA action against Defendants, the United States Department of Defense, the Department of State, and the United States Department of Justice and its component, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (collectively, “Defendants”). *See generally* Compl., ECF No. 1 (Sept. 19, 2014).

Order (Sept. 22, 2016), which the parties filed on September 27, 2016. *See* Joint Status Rep., ECF No. 56 (Sept. 27, 2016). In their September 27, 2016 Joint Status Report, the parties stated that they would confer and submit a joint status report on or before November 18, 2016, which would propose, among other things a production schedule for the CIA. *Id.*

2. The parties respectfully request a short extension of time from November 18, 2016, until December 1, 2016, to submit an updated status report. Good cause exists to grant this motion given both the upcoming holiday and the parties' desire to continue conferring regarding both a production and briefing schedule regarding any remaining issues, including any pending claims against defendants.

For these reasons, the parties respectfully request that the Court grant this motion for extension of time and permit the parties to file a Joint Status Report on or before December 1, 2016.
