ORDER
(Suspending Discovery and Scheduling Conference Call)


This matter comes before the Court following an on-the-record status conference held on January 30, 2024. To efficiently resolve this case, the Court hereby VACATES the scheduling order entered in this matter (ECF No. 9) and SUSPENDS all discovery. The Court further DIRECTS the parties to meet and confer regarding the materials at issue to resolve the case. If the parties fail to reach agreement, the Court DIRECTS the parties to submit a joint pleading of no more than twenty (20) pages by **March 22, 2024**, identifying which materials remain in contention, along with a brief summary of each party's position as to the remaining disputed materials. No attachments to the joint pleading will be permitted.

Finally, the Court hereby SCHEDULES an on-the-record conference call with counsel at 10:30 a.m. on April 9, 2024. If the parties resolve the entirety of their disputes by March 22, 2024, and so report that to the Court, then the conference call on April 9, 2024, will be canceled.

Let the Clerk file a copy of this Order electronically and notify all counsel of record.
