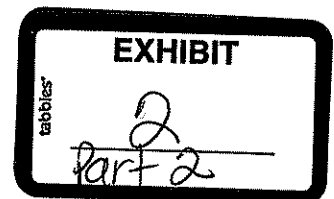

Document Description : This cable, which is currently and properly classified at the SECRET level, is withheld in part pursuant to FOIA Exemptions (b)(1), b(2), (b)(3), (b)(6).

This two page cable contains one page of distribution information and one page of text. The distribution information is withheld on the basis of exemptions b(1), b(2), b(3). The distribution information consists of internal administrative information in which there is no genuine public interest, including filing identifiers, routing codes, handling instructions, origination markings, and other internal administrative information which is protected from disclosure by exemption law b(2). In addition, some of these codes would disclose information such as internal organizational data, the location of CIA facilities overseas, and other information that is properly withheld under exemptions b(1) and b(3) as described more fully below.

Some information in this cable, including the administrative information described above, is also withheld on the basis of exemption b(1).
