However, Roger Hall (plaintiff) claims not to have received any response on these referrals. Because plaintiff claims not to have received a response, the judge is asking CIA to ensure the referrals are being processed. We are requesting that you respond to the requester as soon as possible as CIA has a court deadline of **August 2010**.
