**DECLARATION OF LCDR JESSICA M. HUDSON, JAGC, USN**

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1746, I, Jessica M. Hudson, hereby swear under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my personal knowledge and belief and declare as follows:

1. I am legislative counsel for the United States Navy’s Office of Legislative Affairs. In this capacity, I am immediately responsible for responding to requests for records under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 5 U.S.C. 552 and the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. 552a. I make the following statements based upon my personal knowledge, which in turn is based on my personal review of the case file.

2. This declaration explains the U.S. Navy’s review of CIA Document #C05381571.

3. By letter dated March 11, 2010, Navy was requested to review CIA Document #C05381571 and mark any information deemed not to be releasable.


4. Upon evaluation of CIA Document #C05381571, I determined that a personal privacy interest exists under Title 5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(6) and redacted the name of an officer in the document. In light of recent terrorist activities around the world, the Department of Defense now regularly withholds personally identifying information about all particular military

and civilian employees with respect to whom disclosure would “raise security or privacy concerns.” Department of Defense Director for Administration and Management Memorandum 1-2 (Nov. 9, 2001).

5. I have weighed the public interest in disclosure against the interest in preserving the privacy of the individual named in the document. Using FOIA Exemption (b) (6), I have determined that the interest in preserving the privacy of the personal information outweighs any public interest in disclosure of the personal information.

6. The U.S. Navy has determined that under FOIA Exemption (b)(6), one name on the Memorandum of Understanding contained in CIA Document #C05381571 should be redacted.
