**NOTICE OF FILING OF SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF MARY ELLEN COLE**

The Central Intelligence Agency (“CIA”), by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully submits this Notice of Filing of the Supplemental Declaration of Mary Ellen Cole (“Supplemental Cole Declaration”).

The purpose of the Supplemental Cole Declaration is to further respond to the Court’s November 12, 2009, Order as it pertains to Item 5 of Plaintiffs’ Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) request, which seeks records relating to individuals who allegedly are Vietnam-era POW/MIAs. Supp. Cole Decl. ¶ 3; see Cole Decl. ¶¶ 68-76. The CIA agreed with Plaintiff that no later than January 31, 2011, it would release non-exempt records in the CIA Automatic Declassification and Release Environment responsive to Plaintiffs’ FOIA request. Supp. Cole Decl. ¶ 3. The CIA did so on January 14, 2011. See id. ¶ 5 & id. Exh. A.
