It includes CIA analysis of the organization and refers to specific foreign government entities. The document also contains CIA control markings and other CIA organizational data including CIA record-keeping details and handwritten notations. It is currently and properly classified as SECRET.

This document is withheld in full on the basis of FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3).

Exemption (b)(1): This document is denied in full on the basis of FOIA exemption (b)(1). This
