**DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
FILE A REPLY IN SUPPORT OF ITS MOTION TO STRIKE**

Defendant, through and by undersigned counsel, hereby submits this Motion for Extension of Time to Reply to Plaintiff Hall's Opposition to Defendant's Motion to Strike, in Part, Mr. Hall's Declaration. Defendant requests an extension until and including November 16, 2007.

1. Defendant's Reply to the Oppositions is due on October 17, 2007.
2. Defendant requires an additional 30 days to prepare its Reply to Plaintiffs' Opposition, primarily due to lead counsel's schedule which has recently included emergency matters duty during the week of October 8 - 12, 2007; settlement negotiations in an employment discrimination matter; document review/discovery and motions practice in a protracted Title VII case, and client consultations in a *Bivens* and FTCA matter.
3. Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7(m), undersigned counsel sent an electronic mail message to counsel for Mr. Hall and SSRI. At the time of filing, counsel had not responded.
4. This is the second extension request made for this deadline.
5. Defendant therefore requests an additional 30 days to file its Reply to Plaintiff's Opposition.

WHEREFORE, Defendant requests that this enlargement be granted, and that the date for the filing of its Reply to the Oppositions be extended to November 17, 2007. A minute order is requested.
