



The records have high research value for the information they contain about military personnel and POWs from the Korean War. I recommend that the National Archives accept the offer and transfer the microfilm to the National Archives immediately. I have discussed this job with Elaine Everly (NN-W) and she has informally concurred with the recommendation.

This appraisal concerns N1-AU-90-24, an offer by the United States Army, Office of Freedom of Information Privacy of 20 reels of unidentified microfilm recently discovered in the FOIA office.

In examining the microfilm, I determined that the 20 rolls of 35mm positive duplicate film are copies of unclassified press releases from the Department of Defense, listing Korean War casualties. The initial roll, which might contain pertinent information on how these records came to be filmed, is missing. There is no paper or other documentation. On each reel the beginning frames contain a disclaimer on the accuracy of the lists and "Property of U.S. Govt. 1/25/60."

The first 19 reels are copies of Department of Defense, Office of Public Information Press Releases listing killed in action and wounded in Korea, 1950-1953. The press releases are arranged chronologically with a state by state listing of the casualties. Under each state, the lists are arranged alphabetically by last name and contain the home addresses and names of the next of kin.

The twentieth reel contains the same disclaimer as the first 19, but contains several types of information different from the other reels. Listed are: Strength Requirements of Women's Services; Press Release on Expenditures; General Fact Sheets; and Press Releases relating to POWs. The releases regarding the POWs are arranged by state thereunder alphabetically by last name. They also contain the names and addresses of next of kin. Additionally, there is a listing of captured sick and wounded returned to Military Control in Korea, a list of "Men Reported By Reds to Have Died," various clippings dated August 1955, and a Press Release from the Service Pay Commission. As with the other 19 reels, I did not locate any documentation to explain from where the information derived or how it came to be filmed.

Since the microfilm did not appear to be the record copy, I searched and located the original unclassified press releases in the Records of the Office of the Secretary of Defense (Record Group 330). With the cooperation of OSD,

Documents accumulated by the Defense POW/MIA Office (DPMO) relating to unaccounted for Korean conflict POW/MIAs, ca. 1951-58. To date, the bulk of these materials are copies of documents held by the National Archives but copies of records held by other institutions are also included. This transfer also includes index sheets prepared by DPMO that provide the date, office of origin, and a brief summary of the subject of individual documents; summaries often include the names of specific POWs/MIAs cited in the document. This indexing information is being transferred in paper format and on a diskette; DPMO uses the latter to locate documents when responding to inquiries concerning specific individuals. Also included is ca. 6-8 inches of correspondence between DPMO and the families of unaccounted for POW/MIAs. Section 1031 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1995 mandates the transfer of these documents to the National Archives which is to serve as a "centralized repository" for them.

This appraisal concerns N1-AU-90-24, an offer by the United States Army, Office of Freedom of Information Privacy of 20 reels of unidentified microfilm recently discovered in the FOIA office.

In examining the microfilm, I determined that the 20 rolls of 35mm positive duplicate film are copies of unclassified press releases from the Department of Defense, listing Korean War casualties. The initial roll, which might contain pertinent information on how these records came to be filmed, is missing. There is no paper or other documentation. On each reel the beginning frames contain a disclaimer on the accuracy of the lists and "Property of U.S. Govt. 1/25/60."

The first 19 reels are copies of Department of Defense, Office of Public Information Press Releases listing killed in action and wounded in Korea, 1950-1953. The press releases are arranged chronologically with a state by state listing of the casualties. Under each state, the lists are arranged alphabetically by last name and contain the home addresses and names of the next of kin.

The twentieth reel contains the same disclaimer as the first 19, but contains several types of information different from the other reels. Listed are: Strength Requirements of Women's Services; Press Release on Expenditures; General Fact Sheets; and Press Releases relating to POWs. The releases regarding the POWs are arranged by state thereunder alphabetically by last name. They also contain the names and addresses of next of kin. Additionally, there is a listing of captured sick and wounded returned to Military Control in Korea, a list of "Men Reported By Reds to Have Died," various clippings dated August 1955, and a Press Release from the Service Pay Commission. As with the other 19 reels, I did not locate any documentation to explain from where the information derived or how it came to be filmed.

Since the microfilm did not appear to be the record copy, I searched and located the original unclassified press releases in the Records of the Office of the Secretary of Defense (Record Group 330). With the cooperation of OSD,

This transfer also includes index sheets prepared by DPMO that provide the date, office of origin, and a brief summary of the subject of individual documents; summaries often include the names of specific POWs/MIAs cited in the document. This indexing information is being transferred in paper format and on a diskette; DPMO uses the latter to locate documents when responding to inquiries concerning specific individuals. Also included is ca. 6-8 inches of correspondence between DPMO and the families of unaccounted for POW/MIAs. Section 1031 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1995 mandates the transfer of these documents to the National Archives which is to serve as a "centralized repository" for them.
