They consist for the most part of government or government contract produced studies; research and statistical compilations; and operational histories, reports and plans. The series also includes occasional items of Marine Corps correspondence; Marine Corps memorandums summarizing important meetings, including those of the National Security Council and Joint Chiefs of Staff; and copies of the Secretary of the Navy's weekly reports to the President.

Many of the files document various aspects of the War in Vietnam, but others relate to different matters such as ongoing programs, policies and operations of the armed forces; the Cuban missile crisis; the Lebanon crisis of 1958; reports of U.S. prisoners of war in Laos and Cambodia; and the assault on Koh Trang and the U.S.S. Mayaguez incident. Information concerning various aspects of Marine Corps operations is scattered throughout the entire series, but particularly among the U.S. Navy originated documents. Some of the files that were originally a part of this series are now missing.
